

MINUTES OF THE ISLE ABBOTTS PARISH COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON WEDNESDAY 6TH SEPTEMBER 2017 AT 7.30PM IN THE VILLAGE HALL

PRESENT: Cllrs Habberfield, Bradshaw, Herbert, Hughes, Pix, the Clerk, CC Adam Dance and 1 member of the public.

1. **APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE:** None
2. **There were no DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST.**
3. The **MINUTES** of the last meeting held on Wednesday 5th July 2017 were read and approved.
4. **MATTERS ARISING:** a) Ditch clearance at Badbury. Communications had taken place between John Toon, Dan Martin, Service Manager for Flood Risk Management SCC and David Warburton MP. Little progress had been made but John Toon was still pressing the issue and would keep the Clerk informed on progress. b) Broadband update. CC Adam Dance gave a brief outline of his e-mail exchanges with Katriona Lovelock, the Service Manager of SCC Economy and Planning Group. It is hoped that more information on delivery of Broadband, would be given by the end of September/beginning of October. CC Adam Dance would forward the e-mail from Katriona Lovelock to the Clerk for onward transmission to the Parish Councillors. c) Overnight parking of HGV. It was brought to the Councils attention about the concerns expressed by some villagers over an HGV being parked on a regular basis in a residential area with the operator running the truck engine early in the morning. The Clerk was asked to visit the operator and express the Parish Councils concerns.

6. **ROADS AND FOOTPATHS:** Cllr Herbert reported that Two Bridges had been repaired. Discussions took place about the frequency that the bridge was being damaged and the poor attitude of English Heritage towards suggestions to alleviate ongoing damage. CC Adam Dance requested that the Clerk e-mail him with details on this. The Clerk had reported the lack of jointing to the stonework under the bridge and this had been acknowledged by Highways. Cllr Habberfield had nothing to report on Footpaths.
7. **FLOODING:** Cllr Herbert had nothing to report.
8. **FINANCE:** Cllr Bradshaw advised that the external audit report had been returned with observations which the Council duly noted. He also produced the financial statement up to 06/09/17. Current account £163.96. Deposit account £4,351.26. Total £4,515.22. Payments approved: Musgrove Scanner appeal £50.00: Clerks salary £88.00: HMRC(PAYE) £22.00.

No comments/observations had been submitted by the Parish Council. Application No: 17/03384/LBR by Mr & Mrs Mobbs, Chapel Farmhouse for internal alterations. The paperwork was in the process of being circulated to Councillors for comments/observations. The Clerk had forwarded to Councillors the information about the Electoral Review of the SSDC area. Advice had been received about the Main Street, Ilton road closure for 3 days from 11th October. A notice to this effect had been placed on the website and Parish noticeboard.
